

Y6 Latin – what to revise?

The exam paper will cover everything we have done so far (incl. vocab, noun endings, present, imperfect and perfect tenses and the Greek myths we have studied).

The paper will take the following format: a Language question, requiring you to translate a short Latin passage, and a Mythology question, testing your recall and understanding of one of the myths we have studied this year.

In particular, revise the following:

6.1 the Level 1 vocabulary sheet, **a-suus**, the Endings sheet (distributed) AND **Jason's adventures in Colchis**;

6.2 the Level 1 vocabulary sheet, **a-quod**, the Endings sheet (distributed) AND **Perseus and Medusa**.

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7.1: The exam will be a Level 2 Common Entrance paper (suitably adapted) and will include a comprehension, translation, and mythology question.

7.2: The exam will be a Level 1 Common Entrance paper (suitably adapted) and will include a comprehension, translation, and mythology question.

In particular, **BOTH** sets should learn or know the following:

- a) the **vocab booklet** (Level 1 or Levels 1-2, as appli., distributed)
- b) the **grammar booklet** (Level 1 or Levels 1-2, as applic., distributed)
- c) **Odysseus' homecoming**.

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Scholars set will do a CE Level 3 paper. CE1 will do a CE Level 2 paper. CE2 will do a CE Level 1 paper.

All three sets should learn the **VOCAB** and the **ENDINGS** applicable to their level, using the Vocab and Endings booklets as previously distributed (also available on the pupil Intranet). Do not forget to learn the other stuff that goes with your level (e.g., what does nonne/num? mean?) and is included in the Endings booklet.

All three sets should also learn their **myths** for a CE-style question.
